

Rostra Trouble Shooting Tips **250-1775 Cruise Control Switch Kit**

- 1.** For the gray wire attachment in the BCM, there are two connectors that look the same. Always use connector with white/black wire in position 62, insert gray into position 61 beside white/black.
- 2.** Check Black wire with meter for ground with motor running resistance no higher than 3 ohms.
- 3.** Check Red and Blue with meter for 12volts Ignition power with motor running
- 4.** Make sure that Gray wire is in proper position according to instruction manual for that certain vehicle.
- 5.** Make sure switch is transmitting to module voltage will change on gray wire when you press set or resume with control switch on and ignition on. If no change, reprogram switch to module.
- 6.** Check resistance across harness disconnect gray from vehicle or unplug BCM connector.
Gray to brown will read 7.87K ohms.
Gray to Green will read 1.43K ohms.
Gray To yellow will read 4.22K ohms.
Any resistances not shown, replace kit.
